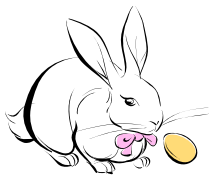


## What's Happening!!!

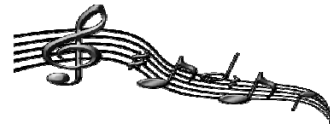

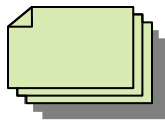


## Preschool Music Concert

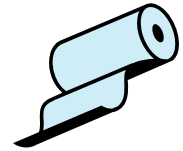
## Scrap Paper Needs
