## Ladies Expo

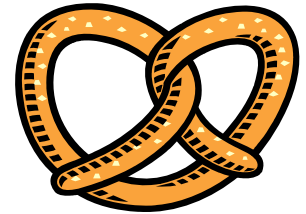

## Personalized Pretzels

1 pkg. dry yeast  
1/2 C. warm water  
1 egg  
1/4 C. honey  
1 tsp. salt  
1/4 C. margarine  
1 C. low-fat milk  
5 C. all-purpose flour  
Coarse salt



Sprinkle and dissolve yeast into warm water. Mix egg yolk, margarine, and milk into the yeast. Add salt and enough flour to make thick, easy-to-handle dough. Knead dough on floured surface for 5 minutes. Let rise 1 hour. Divide into 20 pieces. Roll the dough into "snakes" and form into desired shapes. Place on cookie sheet and brush with beaten egg white. Sprinkle with coarse salt as desired. Bake at 425 degrees F about 17 minutes, until golden brown. Makes 20 pretzels.
